PLAY-UP Club 2024-25: Voices from the Margins: Sport Coaching and Young People

Project details:

Applications are invited for a master's scholarship opportunity in Te Huataki Waiora School of Health. This project is part of a larger programme of research exploring the impact of a child rights approach to coaching. Partnering with Sport Waikato and UNICEF, this project explores the impact of a child rights approach to coaching on a range of youth development outcomes through the PLAY-UP club – a child-centered sports club hosted at the University of Waikato.

Sports coaches and sports clubs are largely responsible for creating positive environments for children to enjoy sport, and to learn, develop and succeed through sport. They also have a profound impact on whether a child's experience in sport is positive, and whether a child benefits physically, socially and/or mentally through their participation (Morley et al., 2021). This project will focus on the development of learner centered pedagogies and how foregrounding children's voices in their choice of sport participation can impact on their own Physical Literacy. Specifically, constraints-based pedagogies and play will be the lens through which autonomy can be facilitated in young learners.

The successful applicant should be eligible to enrol at the University of Waikato. Prior experience in the study and practice of sport coaching would be advantageous.
